TEACH THEM COMPASSION



 Compassion is caring about a situation plus action.

> Role play situations that they may encounter and life and have them decide how they could lead out in compassion.

TEACH PRETEENS ABOUT SPIRITUAL GIFTS & HELP THEM TO IDENTIFY THEIR OWN.

 Challenge preteens to list ways that they can serve using their spiritual gifts now and in the future.

INTRODUCE PRETEENS TO CHURCH LEADERS



- ✓ Let them ask them questions about how' they are serving, how they began serving, and what skills they may need to serve in a similar way.
- Find ways for preteens to shadow leaders in your church.

CHALLENGE PRETEENS TO IDENTIFY AN AREA OF NEED

- Encourage them to look in their church or community.
- ✓ Challenge them to create their own service project to address that need.

GIVE OPPORTUNITIES TO SERVE NOW

 Allow them to serve as helpers with younger students.

Help them find jobs to match their God-given talents and gifts.
